The winner will be announced at our Open Day on November 30th.












































Daycare Tips!





The Weimaraner Featuring Indie-Blue!

Also known as the Gray Ghost, the Weimaraner hails from Germany and the late 1800's. They gain their name from the area of Germany they are thought to have been developed, the city of Weimar.

Originally this strong agile breed was used to hunt large game such as wolves, bears and mountain lions. But as the numbers of large predators dwindled in Europe the Weimaraner turned into a point and retrieve hunting dog of smaller game.

Today the Weimaraner is still used as a loyal hunting dog but also makes a great companion for active families who don't mind having a dog that may be a little smarter than they are.

Underdog Training Tip!

Tips for calmer greetings.

- I. Separate Have your dog in another room while your guests enter.
- 2. Take control For dogs that lack self control introductions should be done on lead. Where you can immediately move the dog away from the guest if they jump or mouth.
- 3. Reinforce Teach your dog that YOU will reinforce them with their favourite treat when they greet guests.
- 4. Toss the treats on the ground to pro-actively teach them to keep their paws on the floor when they greet.
